## **Year 11 Mock Examination Expectations and Standards**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, the Year 11 Mock Examinations begin tomorrow and will run until Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March. These exams are an important opportunity for students to experience formal exam conditions and to identify areas for further improvement ahead of the summer series.

To ensure the exams run smoothly, please take note of the following expectations:

### **Punctuality**

Students must arrive on time for every exam. Morning exams begin promptly, so we strongly encourage students to arrive early to avoid any delays. A free breakfast will be available from 8:00am each morning to support students in being prepared and ready for the day.

### **Uniform**

All students are expected to attend in full school uniform throughout the exam period. This helps maintain a calm, consistent, and focused environment.

### **Exam Rules**

To comply with exam regulations:

- Mobile phones must be switched off and can be placed in a labelled wallet and stored in a secure box alternatively they can remain in the students' bag if they prefer. Any student found with a phone or smartwatch in the exam room may be disqualified from that paper.
- Handheld scanners will be used before entry to ensure no prohibited items are brought into the exam hall.
- All normal exam conditions apply, including silence upon entering and leaving the room and following instructions from invigilators at all times.
